WHERE WE BEGAN

WE'VE BEEN DOING THIS SINCE 1923

1923

Croydon Voluntary Association For The Blind (CVAB) was formed.

1924

The Ministry of Health granted CVAB £100 pa to appoint an administrator and teacher, to support people with sight loss as well as an office space.

1939

War Time Evacuation - Approximately 90 blind people and 60 necessary guides were evacuated to East Sussex County Council with CVAB paying for their board and lodgings.

1973


Bedford Hall became the headquarters and social centre for CVAB. Tansport was provided to bring members into Bedford House for activities and socials, plus keep fit club and handicraft classes. Wireless sets were given to members along with various aids provided by the RNIB. Financial help was given to those in need. Grants were given to owners of guide dogs.

1980

The Queen makes a visit to CVAB to see the various work at hand, supporting people with sight loss. Furthermore, to appreciate volunteers and staff.
